International Fee Waiver Guidelines

- A. Prior to applying for International Fee Waiver, undergraduate student-athlete must submit transcripts to CSUB Admissions and Records for review.
- B. Transcripts must be submitted no later than June 1, 2010.
- C. CSUB Admissions and Records are responsible for evaluating each transcript as soon as received.
- D. CSUB Admissions and Records will provide evaluation of transcripts to Gloria Friedman, Sr. Associate Athletic Director for final review.
- E. To be considered for an International Fee Waiver, undergraduate student-athlete must have at least a 2.8 cumulative GPA.
- F. Undergraduate international student-athlete must be Division I certified through the NCAA Clearinghouse.
- G. Coaches are responsible for completing CSUB Athletic Department International Fee Waiver Form.
- H. It is important to include all prior academic performances and athletic performances. You may include other considerations as well.
- I. Each International Fee Waiver form must be signed and approved by head coach and Sr. Associate Athletic Director.
- J. International Fee Waivers may not exceed the maximum of 15 units per quarter.
- K. The determination of international fee waivers is based on Division I certification, gender equity requirements, GPA and previous international fee waiver allocations.
- L. International Fee Waivers are limited to one year. Student-athlete must apply each year.
- M. Undergraduate student-athlete must be accepted for admission to CSUB and must declare an academic major within the first year.
- N. Undergraduate student-athlete must enroll in at least 12 units each academic term to be considered a “full-time” undergraduate student.
- O. Undergraduate student-athlete must maintain “good academic standing” as well as eligibility within NCAA Division I compliance each term with a minimum 2.0 GPA to continue receiving an international fee waiver for each additional term of the academic year.
- P. Undergraduate student-athlete must be formally nominated for a fee waiver by the appropriate coach and approved by the Sr. Associate Athletic Director.
